1 Background

1.1 This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on the 8th day of September 2021 between the following parties:

(a) **CANTA CONSULTANTS LLP**, a limited liability partnership registered in India with LLP identification Number AAI-4805, whose registered office is at E-20 Hauz Khas (1st & 2nd Floors), New Delhi 110015, India, which works under the brand name 'The Hearth Education Advisors' and hereinafter called the "Hearth", and

(b) **GURUKUL MAHILA ARTS AND COMMERCE COLLEGE, PORBANDAR**, a College located at Jubilee, Bokhira, A, Porbandar, Gujarat 360575 and hereinafter called the "University"

1.2 The initial timeframe for this MoU shall be one year, commencing the date first written above.

2 Aims

2.1 This MoU's overarching aim is to establish a **Mind Over Matter Peer Support Chapter** at the University, which shall help the University destigmatise mental health and normalise reaching out for support amongst its young adult student community.

2.2 Mind Over Matter ("**MoM**") is a pro-bono volunteer organisation run by young adults, supported by the Hearth, which equips the youth with resources to look after their mental health. Several young people are struggling with mental health issues, and MoM strives to destigmatise these concerns and to assist the Indian youth in attaining an emotional and mental balance.

2.3 Peer Support: A peer supporter is a person who knows from their own experience with a condition, or from helping others or has received training to be empathic and understanding. Peer support is frequent, ongoing, accessible, and flexible. MoM's Peer Support Training Programme has a training manual supplemented by regular theoretical webinars and practical training calls with MoM's mental health professionals (psychologists, counsellors and life coaches).

3 Service Plan

3.1 Under this MoU, the Hearth will offer a Service Plan to the University to establish a **Mind Over Matter Peer Support Chapter** at the University.

3.2 MoM will provide the University with a training manual for peer supporters (designed and reviewed by professional psychologists)

- 3.3 MoM will also provide a structured course conducted by its mental health professionals and advisors to give the University's peer support volunteers further training and equip them to handle any minor issue faced by the student body.
- 3.4 Additionally, MoM will conduct practice calls for the peer support team.
- 3.5 The peer supporters primarily act as an extra support system for students at the University and are only responsible for minor and day-to-day issues. The peer-support services are entirely free of charge.
- 3.6 MoM would assist and handle the administrative and organisational responsibilities and training of the student representatives for establishing the Peer Support Chapter at the University.
- 3.7 The above described Service Plan, including the time of the mental health professionals for the training of the peer support volunteers, will be provided free to the University by MoM.
- 3.8 However, neither the Health nor Mind Over Matter take any legal responsibility or liability for actions of the Peer Support Chapter of the University.

4 Responsibilities of the University

- 4.1 The University will commit between 10 and 20 students who would undergo training to become peer support volunteers and ONE faculty member who would oversee the Peer Support Chapter at the University. The training period for the faculty member as well as the students would be for a time period of one week at a time that is convenient for the University and Mind Over Matter.
- 4.2 Upon the completion of the training, the students would be expected to write a short reflective essay. They would then be required to commit a maximum of 2 hours a week for their responsibilities as peer supporters.
- 4.3 The University would widely publicise the Peer Support Chapter through the University's regular marketing channels, emails and website.
- 4.4 The faculty member from the University would need to contact the Mind Over Matter team and provide updates of a pre-determined format that would be agreed upon with the University.

5 Additionalities

- 5.1 It is recognised that the Peer Support Chapter will encounter those students whose concerns are beyond the peer support volunteers' ability to assist. When this occurs, there will be available a network of professional partners in helping such individuals. Currently, Mind Over Matter is working with 18 mental health

professionals. For ongoing sessions with our professionals, the professional directly charges a subsidised rate to the user.

- 5.2 Mind Over Matter works with the UK based AI firm Healthmine, which uses its proprietary technology to match users with the mental health professional best suited to them. Working with Healthmine has ensured that user matching is done effectively and efficiently and can enhance user experience with the organisation.
- 5.3 University students who require support beyond what the peer supporters can give will also have the option of being referred to mental health professionals. It should be noted that while this Service Plan is offered free of cost to the University, individual professional referrals beyond the Peer Support Chapter will have a fee paid directly to the mental health professional (at a special Mind Over Matter subsidised rate).

6 Designated Leads

- 6.1 Each party mentioned above will appoint a senior member of staff to lead on the work under this MoU.

7 Disclaimer

- 7.1 It should be noted that the parties are not committing to legally binding obligations by signing this MoU document. It is intended that the parties remain independent of each other and that their collaboration and participation in the activities of this MoU does not constitute the creation of a legal entity nor authorise the entry into a commitment for or on behalf of each other.





MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. SCOPE AND PURPOSE:

 - Provide opportunities to students discover hidden talents and skills.
 - Improve networking and establish relationships with foreign organizations providing technical support expanding their exposure.
 - Develop them as empowered youth to become responsible citizens of the country.

2. TERM OF MOU:

- i. The MOU is effective upon the day and date last signed and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this MOU and the governing bodies of the parties' respective countries or municipalities.



- ii. The MOU may be terminated, without cause, by either party without notice, informing the authorities through official email.
- iii. The coordinator representing the college must give full support and must be available to organize the events that are pre-planned.
- iv. The college must provide space (inside the college campus) for the coordinator and the students (part of YUCI) to work for the events.

3. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

i. Amendments

Either party may request changes to this MOU. Any changes, modifications, revisions or amendments to this MOU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MOU shall be incorporated by written instrument, and effective when executed and signed by all parties to this MOU.

ii. Entirety of Agreement

This MOU, consisting of {5 pages} represents the entire and integrated agreement between the parties and supercedes all prior negotiations, representations and agreements, whether written or oral.

iii. Severability

If any portion of this MOU has been judicially determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MOU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the severance.

iv. Sovereign Immunity

The [requesting law enforcement agency] and the [assigning law enforcement agency] and their respective governing bodies do not waive their sovereign immunity by entering into this MOU, and each fully retains all immunities and defenses provided by law with respect to any action based on or occurring as a result of this MOU.



v. **Third Party Beneficiary Rights**

The parties do not intend to create in any other individual or entity the status of a third party beneficiary, and this MOU shall not be construed so as to create such status. The rights, duties and obligations contained in this MOU shall operate only between the parties to this MOU, and shall inure solely to the benefit of the parties to this MOU.

vi. **Obligations**

1. In accordance with conducting events, the YUCI may require the college's space, students and whatever the case may demand with prior consent of the college.
2. The provisions of this MOU are intended only to assist the parties in determining and performing their obligations accordingly.
3. The parties to this MOU intend and expressly agree that only parties signatory to this MOU shall have any legal or equitable right to seek to enforce this MOU, to seek any remedy arising out of a party's performance or failure to perform any term or condition of this MOU, or to bring an action for the breach of this MOU.

4. **BENEFITS OFFERED TO THE COLLEGE:**

- i. Conduct art, cultural, sports events for the students to show up their talents and to improve their skills in organizing these kind of event.
- ii. Develop personality of the students through various utilitarian webinars/seminars etc.
- iii. Improved resume and conduct placement programs.
- iv. International programs will be conducted for the exposure of students and staffs.
- v. Students empowerment and faculty development programs will be conducted.
- vi. Interaction and recognition with international speakers .

- vii. Different offline activities will be organized for the development and empowerment of the students.
- viii. Emphasis and empower with beneficial courses.
Students foreign exchange program may be offered.

- Establish potential foundation by involving colleges.


6. TERMS AND CONDITIONS:



1 Background

- 1.1 This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on the 8th day of September 2021 between the following parties:
 - (a) **CANTA CONSULTANTS LLP**, a limited liability partnership registered in India with LLP Identification Number AAI-4805, whose registered office is at E-20 Hauz Khas (1st & 2nd Floors), New Delhi 110016, India, which works under the brand name 'The Health Education Advisors' and hereinafter called the "Health"; and
 - (b) **GURUKUL MAHILA ARTS AND COMMERCE COLLEGE, PORBANDAR**, a College located at Jubilee, Bakhira, Al. Porbandar, Gujarat 360575 and hereinafter called the "University"
- 1.2 The initial timeframe for this MoU shall be one year, commencing the date first written above.

2 Aims

- 2.1 The MoU's overarching aim is to establish a **Mind Over Matter Peer Support Chapter** at the University, which shall help the University destigmatise mental health and normalise reaching out for support amongst its young adult student community.
- 2.2 Mind Over Matter ("**MoM**") is a pro-bono volunteer organisation run by young adults, supported by the Health, which equips the youth with resources to look after their mental health. Several young people are struggling with mental health issues, and MoM strives to destigmatise these concerns and to assist the Indian youth in attaining an emotional and mental balance.
- 2.3 Peer Support: A peer supporter is a person who knows from their own experience with a condition, or from helping others or has received training to be empathic and understanding. Peer support is frequent, ongoing, accessible, and flexible. MoM's Peer Support Training Programme has a training manual supplemented by regular theoretical webinars and practical training calls with MoM's mental health professionals (psychologists, counsellors and life coaches).

3 Service Plan

- 3.1 Under this MoU, the Health will offer a Service Plan to the University to establish a Mind Over Matter Peer Support Chapter at the University.
- 3.2 MoM will provide the University with a training manual for peer supporters (designed and reviewed by professional psychologists)

- 3.3. MoM will also provide a structured course conducted by its mental health professionals and advisors to give the University's peer support volunteers further training and equip them to handle any minor issue faced by the student body.
- 3.4. Additionally, MoM will conduct practice calls for the peer support team.
- 3.5. The peer supporters primarily act as an extra support system for students at the University and are only responsible for minor and day-to-day stresses. The peer support services are entirely free of charge.
- 3.6. MoM would assist and handle the administrative and organisational responsibilities and training of the student representatives for establishing the Peer Support Chapter at the University.
- 3.7. The above detailed Service Plan, including the time of the mental health professionals for the training of the peer support volunteers, will be provided free to the University by MoM.
- 3.8. However, neither the Hearth nor Mind Over Matter take any legal responsibility or liability for actions of the Peer Support Chapter of the University.

4 Responsibilities of the University

- 4.1. The University will commit between 10 and 20 students who would undergo training to become peer support volunteers and ONE faculty member who would oversee the Peer Support Chapter at the University. The training period for the faculty member as well as the students would be for a time period of one week at a time that is convenient for the University and Mind Over Matter.
- 4.2. Upon the completion of the training, the students would be expected to write a short reflective essay. They would then be required to commit a maximum of 2 hours a week for their responsibilities as peer supporters.
- 4.3. The University would widely publicise the Peer Support Chapter through the University's regular marketing channels, emails and website.
- 4.4. The faculty member from the University would need to contact the Mind Over Matter team and provide updates of a pre-determined format that would be agreed upon with the University.

5 Additionalities

- 5.1. It is recognised that the Peer Support Chapter will encounter those students whose concerns are beyond the peer support volunteers' ability to assist. When this occurs, there will be available a network of professional partners in helping such individuals. Currently, Mind Over Matter is working with 18 mental health

professionals. For ongoing sessions with our professionals, the professional directly charges a subsidised rate to the user.

- 5.2 Mind Over Matter works with the UK based AI firm Healthmine, which uses its proprietary technology to match users with the mental health professional best suited to them. Working with Healthmine has ensured that user matching is done effectively and efficiently and can enhance user experience with the organisation.
- 5.3 University students who require support beyond what the peer supporters can give will also have the option of being referred to mental health professionals. It should be noted that while this Service Plan is offered free of cost to the University, individual professional referrals beyond the Peer Support Chapter will have a fee paid directly to the mental health professional (at a special Mind Over Matter subsidised rate).

6 Designated Leads

- 6.1 Each party mentioned above will appoint a senior member of staff to lead on the work under this MoU.

7 Disclaimer

- 7.1 It should be noted that the parties are not committing to legally binding obligations by signing this MoU document. It is intended that the parties remain independent of each other and that their collaboration and participation in the activities of this MoU does not constitute the creation of a legal entity nor authorise the entry into a commitment for or on behalf of each other.
