Alfred Lord Tennyson

"My strength is as the strength of ten, because my heart is pure".

- (1) **Early Life** :- Tennyson was born on 6 August 1809 in England.
→ He attained his basic education and then went to the trinity college, Cambridge university.
- (2) **Education** :- Tennyson attained his basic education at King Edward VI Grammar School, Louth.
→ He entered Trinity college, Cambridge in 1827.
→ There he joined a secret society called Cambridge Apostles.
- (3) **Famous Works** :- Tennyson's first publication was Poems, chiefly lyrical (1830) which included the popular poem Mariana.
→ The Lady of Shalott, The Lotus-Eaters, Morte d'Arthur and Ulysses appeared in 1842 in the two volume poems which established his reputation as a writer.
- (4) **Achievements** :- In 1829, Tennyson received Chancellor's Gold Medal at Cambridge for one of his first pieces, Timbuctoo.
- (5) **Literary Contribution of Alfred Lord Tennyson** :- Not only did his writing reflect upon the Victorian Era, but they also reflected upon himself. His poetry is easily understood by any generation.
- (6) **Famous Quots by Tennyson** :-
→ "Knowledge comes, but wisdom lingers".
→ "A lie which is half a truth is even the blackest of lies".




