

Press-note

For decades, Gurukul Mahila Arts and Commerce College in Porbandar, deeply rooted in Gandhian ideology, organised a week-long programme dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi under the guidance and inspiration of Principal Dr. Anupam Nagar and under the banner of the Gandhi Vichar Prachar Prasar Committee. The event was held under the leadership of Chairperson Dr. Ketki Pandya with the cooperation of the college faculty.

Throughout the week, students presented quizzes on Gandhi's life and sayings, inspirational incidents from his life, and his valuable teachings during the prayer assemblies held at Sharada Mandir.

In addition, students from the English, Hindi, Gujarati, Home Science, Economics, and Commerce departments conducted cleanliness drives in different parts of the college under the guidance of their respective heads.

During the weekly programme, a play titled Shiksha Ej Samruddhi (Education is Prosperity), written and directed by Chetan Dave, was staged by a group of eleven students. The play brought to life the educational philosophies of Mahatma Gandhi, Swami Dayanand Saraswati, and the Greek philosopher Plato through dramatic portrayals of their characters.

A highly engaging and intellectually enriching 'My Nation, My Pride' mega quiz competition was also organised as part of the week's activities. Nine teams participated, including students from the English, Hindi, Gujarati, Home Science, Economics, Commerce (Gujarati Medium), Commerce (English Medium) departments of the college, as well as from Government Arts College, Ranavav, and K.H. Madhvani College, Porbandar. The winning team was awarded a cash prize.

Additionally, on Gandhi Jayanti, an online quiz was organised based on Gandhi's autobiography The Story of My Experiments with Truth, where students answered questions through Google Forms. Students also participated in the Gandhi Jayanti celebration held at Kirti Mandir. In the evening, they visited the art exhibition Kala-Sarla by Sarla Majmudar at the Maharana Natwarsinhji Art Gallery, accompanied by Dr. Ketki Pandya, Chairperson of the Gandhi Vichar Prachar Prasar Committee, and Dr. Ilu Gamit. The exhibition, organised in memory of Sarla Majmudar, a staunch Gandhian thinker, showcased her paintings of Gandhi. Sarla Majmudar was known for leading an anti-addiction movement in a small village near Surat and for inspiring village children about Gandhi's life through her artwork. Visiting this exhibition on the auspicious occasion of Gandhi Jayanti was a deeply meaningful experience.

Thus, the entire week was dedicated to the Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi. The programme's success was made possible through the efforts of Dr. Ketki Pandya, members Aditi Dave and Parul Shukla, the entire faculty, and the enthusiastic participation of the students.
