social service activities were successfully organised. Even after retirement, he continues to actively participate in social service activities. In recognition of his outstanding contribution to society, he was honoured with the “Humanitarian Champion Award” by the Indian Red Cross Society, New Delhi, in 2018. Such a distinguished personality, Dr. C. G. Joshi, was felicitated with a *Sutmala* and memento by the Principal, Dr. Anupam R. Nagar.

Dr. Joshi, then, unfurled the National Flag and led the flag salutation. Expressing his respect for the nation, he stated that the freedom fighters who gave us independence are no longer with us, but it is our responsibility to preserve the freedom they secured. He recalled that when former Prime Minister Indira Gandhi was asked by a journalist, twenty-five years after independence, what the nation had achieved, she replied that the country had preserved its freedom. Dr. Joshi added that even after 77 years of independence, we have been largely successful in safeguarding our freedom. He emphasised that instead of mocking others for their lack of skills, we should support them and help each other learn. Such cooperation ultimately benefits both individuals and the nation.

On this occasion, the NCC organised a march-past inspection and demonstration. Following which the NSS Volunteers led the Cultural celebrations which became the main attraction of the day. The cultural performances included patriotic song by Afasana Kharaj (Har Karam Apna Kareng), Sanskrit speech by Pooja Hodar (Mam Desh Bharat), patriotic dance by Roshni Parmar (Des Rangila), patriotic group song by Bhagwati Sutreja and group (Kasumbino Rang), Hindi speech by Gita Kadchha (Patriotism: A Power for Nation Building), a short play by Gita Odedra and group (National Festivals and Our Duties), motivational speech by Dr. Sharmishtha Patel, patriotic group dance by Viral Buhecha and group (Fusion), Talwar Raas by Jagruti Khandar, patriotic group dance by Mittal Jadav and group (Vande Mataram), mono-acting by Roshni Parmar (Road Safety), and flag dance by NCC cadets (Jai Ho). Finally, both departments presented their songs with dignity at the end of the Programme.

The Programme concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by NSS Programme Officer Dr. Namrata Samani.
